Dining Service Protocols

- Consistent with Executive Order 49 FY 19/20, **members are required to wear cloth face coverings when in a food service facility** where social distancing is difficult (e.g., waiting in line for pickup, entering or exiting, walking to the restrooms). Members do not need to wear face coverings when seated at the table.
- Maintain 6 feet physical distance to the extent possible. Maintain physical distancing protocols during guest check-in and seating.
- Use reservations with call ahead.
- Maximum group party size of 6 people.
- Everyone in your party must be here before proceeding to your table.
- Avoid crowding at restaurant entrance and maintain physical distancing in any waiting line.
- Children need to remain seated with their party.
- Members should not come to the Club if they have a fever or cough.
- Early hours available to seniors and other high-risk individuals (4-5:30 PM)
- To minimize member and staff interactions we will be assigning wait staff to 'areas' and tables. We will keep staff work groups to same days/shifts to minimize staff exposures when possible,
- Limit restroom occupancy for group restrooms to incorporate physical distancing and avoid formation of waiting lines outside of restrooms.
- PYC will be using disposable menus.
- We will continue take out/curbside for those that do not want to eat in or on the deck.
- Dining tables are spaced at least 6 feet apart.
- The total number of people at any one time should be no more than 50 people per room and each party must be 6 feet apart from other parties. This also applies to outdoor seating areas.
- PYC will be using EPA-approved cleaning and disinfectant products to wipe down dining room tables and chairs after each party.
- We will provide only single use condiments at this time.
- Please enter the deck/patio from the stairs in the front of the Club. Do not use the side entrance near the shed as tables will be placed there for dining.
